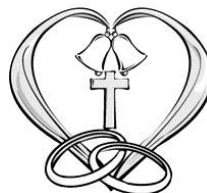

**Greetings from St. Mary's School**

Summer is off to a great start! Summer enrichment classes are underway for our students and professional development classes are underway for our faculty and staff.

Guest speakers stopped in throughout the mornings during the second week of summer enrichment for students to share tips and techniques for helping others. An officer from the Shelby police force brought bicycle and travel safety training, a fireman took them on a tour of an ambulance, and they even had a visit from a life guard who gave students tips and techniques for water safety. Friday, they concluded the two week study with a trip to the library and to Paul's. We have been blessed to have the expertise and talents of Mrs. Swanger, Mrs. Lynch, Mrs. Little, Mrs. Moore, and Mrs. Keinath teaching the sessions. The next round of summer enrichment begins July 6<sup>th</sup>.

Faculty and staff have been very busy with classes, designed for continuous improvement in maintaining each student's individualized plan for his or her just right learning level. We are also implementing a new system for gradebook that will more effectively integrate the school's management tools with classroom and parent communication.

Interviews to fill our teaching/staffing positions for the 2015-16 school year are underway and we look forward to announcing our all-star line-up.

Open enrollment is underway. Being able to provide a Catholic education is truly a blessing. The school office summer hours are Monday – Thursday 7 a.m. – 4 p.m., closed on Fridays. If an appointment outside of those hours is needed, we are happy to schedule that by appointment.

Our referral program is alive and well too! Several parish and school families have already taken advantage of the program. New families referred by a parish or school family receive a 20% discount on tuition per student. If the referring family has students enrolled, they too will receive a 20% discount! Please contact the school office for details.

There is still time to apply for Ohio EdChoice Expansion scholarships. Families with students entering grades k, 1, 2 who meet income eligibility guidelines, can apply for scholarships valued at up to \$2,495! We offer several additional forms of financial assistance, including the Phillips Scholarship, Most Pure Heart of Mary Excel Beyond the Basics, and a Leap of Faith grant for \$1500/student over 2-yrns to parish families who are transferring 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> graders to St. Mary's School.

Our amazing maintenance team is doing a phenomenal job of giving the school its summer overhaul. The old trailer is even coming down! Thank you for taking such good care of us Ken, Kevin and Dave!
